## ELLISFIELD PARISH COUNCIL BUDGET 2024/25

## Summary narrative:

- 1. Precept (currently £5521) to be increased for 2024/25 by 10% to £6073. See below for the rationale for this
- 2. Fixed Costs (£14,181). We are heavily reliant on Grants and Donations to subsidise the Fixed costs at around 49% for 2024/25. With this in mind and the fact that the Precept has not increased for 10 years, the Parish Council would recommend we increase it for the next few years to ensure we have enough funding to minimise the risk to the precept as well as allocating for Projects (see below)
- 3. Grants and Donations assume we will get an extra £4K from Amber Solar. If not then then we will need to take £4K from reserves to top up fixed costs. Going forward Richard and I agreed we should look to increase this number from other sources where possible so that we have sufficient funds for Projects as well as keeping the precept to a more appropriate level.
- 4. Projects. £3700 has been ringfenced for Ear Marked Reserves (EMR) covering Lower Common playground replacement in 10 years, Village signs (in 2 years) and History of Ellisfield to be implemented in 2024/2025. The Speed Device on Axford road will need to be replaced in 3-4 years time. However, we will start allocation of funding from 2025/2026 onwards for this.
- 5. Reserves in 2023/24 have taken a hit of £2100 due to removal of dangerous/unstable of Ash Trees at Hill Farm Pond. Going forward the remainder of the Ash trees are still affected by disease but have foliage so plan to spread the cost across the next 2 years. HCC have confirmed they are happy with the progress to date. 2024/25 Budget figure has been reduced to reflect this.
- 6. Lengthsman costs were reassessed at the beginning of the year to a more realistic figure resulting in an increase to £2450. A large part of the revised cost is due to annual maintenance of the Flood Defences in Green Lane, Furzen Lane and Bell Lane plus general maintenance. Following a discussion with our lengthsman we've reduced the effort on general maintenance but kept the focus on the Main Flood Defences resulting in a reduction of £500 to £1950 for the coming year
- 7. Parish Council has agreed to factor in an annual donation to cover the cost of Broadband for the Memorial Hall
- 8. Section 137 Payment is a audit requirement to cover unexpected costs that may arise during the year
